

## History

The Putney General Store has a long history. Here is an abbreviated timeline of the store's journey from pre-Revolutionary America to today.

T	$Circa\ 1765$ – Charles Kathan erects a saw mill on the 2-acre parcel of land where the store currently stands
ł	<b>1796-1799</b> – William Sargeant and his partner John Griffin build the general store portion of the building
+	<b>1886</b> – After changing hands several times, the store becomes the "A.M. Corser Store" named after owner Adelbert M. Corser
+	1915 - The "A.M. Corser Store" became the "S.L. Davis Store" operated by Simon and Nyra Davis
+	<b>1949</b> – The "S.L. Davis Store" became the "Cummings Store" run by Oscar and Bessie Cummings
+	<b>1966</b> - The store became "Fickett's General Store" owned by Albert and Mary Fickett
+	<b>1974</b> - Robert and Anne Fairchild and family began their era as "Putney General Store"
+	2008 – 1st fire occurs on May 8th
+	2009 – 2nd fire occurs on November 1st
Ţ	<b>2019 – present</b> – Mike and Kim Cosco purchased and operate The Putney General Store
